IMPORTANT

The terms and conditions embodied in this permit require the applicant to complete this work by the date specified in the permit. Where applicant fails to comply with the condition as to completion of work by the time specified, the following rules will govern:

- a) Failure to start work by date specified for completion. Permit will be cancelled unless applicant desires an extension of time, in which case a supplemental permit may be issued.
- b) Work started and not completed by specified date. Applicant will notify the Township, prior to expiration of allotted time, of inability to complete the work on or before the date specified and request an extension of time. Such request shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- c) Applicant not desirous of carrying out proposed work due to change in conditions affecting it. Applicant will notify the Township prior to the date specified for completion that the work will not be carried forward, returning the permit with such notice. The fee for inspection of the work will be refunded by the Township, provided that they have been notified of cancellation prior to the expiration date.

The fees to be paid under the conditions in (a), (b), and (c) apply only to permits for which fees are collected in accordance with the fixed schedule, which may be amended from time to time by the Board of Supervisors.

All notices relative to time extensions or cancellations shall be forwarded to the Township which issued the original permit.

**EAST ALLEN TOWNSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR ROADS, STREETS, ALLEYS OR ANY
ASPHALT SURFACE OWNED BY EAST ALLEN TOWNSHIP**

1. Any trench excavations should be undertaken at right angles to the centerline of the asphalt surface.
2. The Contractor must obtain "Underground Utility" clearances from all underground utility operators.
3. Traffic maintenance and protection signage and traffic control should be undertaken in accordance with PennDOT specifications for "Short Term" activities.
4. The proper pavement restoration, security and bonding should be in place with the Township and in accordance with Township Ordinances.
5. Cutting the pavement should be done with a saw.
6. All excavation backfill material should be 2A modified stone (or equal) in layers in accordance with PennDOT procedures.
7. Temporary restoration shall be with two (2) inches of ID 2A wearing course material, tamped, and rolled in place to be flush with finished paving. Such temporary restoration to be left in place a minimum of ninety (90) days.
8. Temporary restoration shall be maintained in good and passable condition for full term of the maintenance period and until permanent restoration is made.
9. Permanent restoration shall be undertaken as follows:
 - A. Temporary paving and stone and existing paving and base material shall be cut back for a distance of one (1') foot on each side of the trench. This material shall be removed to a depth of 5½ inches for the full width of the cut. This cutting shall be done by way of a saw to provide for a smooth vertical edge.
 - B. BCBC shall be installed to the full width of the trench for a thickness of a minimum of four (4) inches (leaving sufficient space for 1½ inches of ID-2 Wearing Course material). This BCBC material shall be provided and placed in accordance with Section 305 of PennDOT Publication 408. This Wearing Course shall be paved smooth with adjacent asphalt surfaces.
 - C. ID-2 Wearing Course material shall be placed across the trench area to the limit of the cut as described above for a minimum compacted thickness of 1½ inches. This ID-2 material shall be provided and placed in accordance with Section 420 of PennDOT Publication 408. This Wearing Course shall be paved smooth with adjacent asphalt surfaces.
 - D. Paving to paving joints and paving to curb joints shall be sealed with proper joint sealer material and sanded.
 - E. All final paving restoration shall be done only after notice (24 hours) to the Township so that the Township or representative can provide inspection of BCBC paving and ID 2 Wearing Course paving.
